## What else is contained in annex VI of the Vienna Declaration? 2/3

- THE PEP implementation mechanisms: an important element to implement the workplan
- Lead countries or organizations facilitate the implementation of activities in the workplan and act as coordinator and/or rapporteur
- THE PEP workplan for 2021–2025 will be implemented in cooperation with national and international governmental and non-governmental stakeholders
- Implementation of the proposed activities **will be conditional on the mobilization of the necessary resources**

- Structure of the workplan
  - 9 programme areas
  - Programme area 1 → implementation of the overall THE PEP vision
  - Programme areas 2-9 → each corresponds to focus area n para 2 (a)-(h) in the Vienna Declaration
  - Lead country/organization is indicated (since implementation depends on it)
  - Indication of implementation mechanisms and of
  - Relevant SDGs

Development of a comprehensive pan-European strategy on transport, health and environment, (taking into account the experiences of the COVID-19 crisis)	Steering Committee and lead country		By 2023		
Development of proposals for a possible legal instrument in line with THE PEP vision and the Priority Goals, for consideration by the Sixth High-level Meeting on Transport, Health and Environment	Steering Committee and lead country		By 2025
